China

Etiquette and Manners

- Bowing or nodding is common; shaking hands is also acceptable, especially in formal settings.
- Gifts are often given to show respect or gratitude, with specific customs around what gifts are appropriate and how they should be presented and received.
- It's polite to offer food to others before serving yourself, and finishing all the food on your plate is seen as respectful.



Family & Social Structure

Family is the cornerstone of Chinese society. The concept of "filial piety" is central, requiring children to respect and care for their parents and ancestors. Family gatherings, especially during festivals, are significant, with multi-generational households being common.

Food and Cuisine

Chinese cuisine is diverse and integral to cultural identity, with regional variations and unique culinary traditions. Meals are often communal, with dishes shared among all diners. Key practices include using chopsticks, the importance of balance in flavors, and the cultural significance of tea.

Traditional Medicine

Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) is a holistic approach to health that has been practiced for thousands of years.

Practices include acupuncture, herbal medicine, tai chi, and dietary therapy, all aimed at balancing the body's energy (qi).

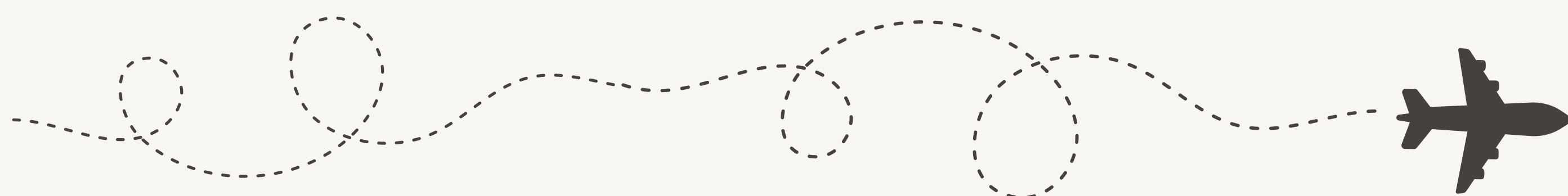

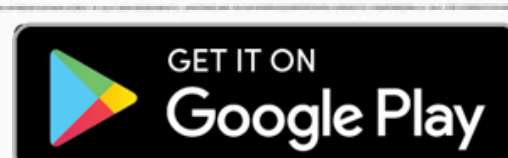
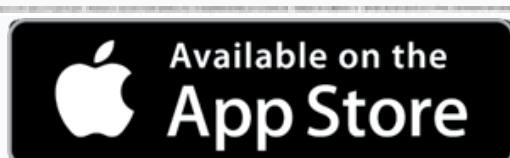

Travel Roll-up Compression Bags

If you are in serious need of saving space in your luggage, a great way to get it is by using travel roll-up compression bags.

These bags will compress your clothing allowing you to duplicate your available space. You do have to keep in mind the more stuff you put in, the more your luggage will weigh. Keep in mind your airline weight restrictions to avoid extra charges.

European Budget Airlines

Can't wait to go to Europe? The cheapest way to do it is by flying on an European budget airline. They are not as bad as some of our domestic budget airlines (not naming names) in the U.S. and prices are very competitive against prices offered by major U.S. airlines.

Some of the ones I've personally used are Level, Vueling, IcelandAir, and Norse Atlantic. They are totally doable and vary in prices and amenities offered, so do your research before booking. Other options are RyanAir, EasyJet, WizzAir, and EuroWings.

If you have points/miles available use a U.S. airline, otherwise, consider foreign airlines.

Frontier Airlines adds Bundled Fare Options

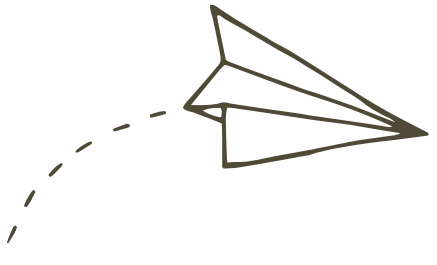
On May 17th Frontier Airlines revised their merchandising strategy by offering and “Economy Bundle” that includes carry-on bags and a standard seat.
