#### Egypt

#### Customs & Traditions

Understanding social customs is essential for respectful interactions and building relationships in Egypt.

- Greetings: A warm handshake is common, and men and women may exchange kisses on the cheeks in social settings. The phrase "Salam Alaikum" (Peace be upon you) is a common greeting.
- Hospitality: Guests are treated with great respect and offered food and drink as a sign of welcome. It is customary to remove shoes when entering someone's home.
- Respect for Elders: Elders are highly respected, and their advice and opinions are valued in family and social matters.





#### Arts & Crafts

- Papyrus Art: Creating artwork on papyrus paper, an ancient craft still practiced today.
- Khayamiya: Traditional Egyptian applique used for tent making and decorative purposes.
- Handmade Jewelry: Using silver, gold, and semi-precious stones, reflecting ancient designs and symbols.

#### Cuisine and Dining Etiquette

Meals are often communal, with family and friends sharing dishes. Staple foods include:

- Ful Medames: Cooked fava beans, often eaten for breakfast.
- Koshari: A popular street food made of rice, lentils, pasta, and tomato sauce.
- Molokhia: A green leafy soup served with rice and meat or chicken.
- Baklava and Basbousa: Sweet pastries commonly enjoyed for dessert.

#### Family Values

Family is the cornerstone of Egyptian society, with strong emphasis on kinship, respect for elders, and communal living. Extended families often live close to each other, and family gatherings are frequent.



This bottle is leakproof, resealable, and once empty it compresses to about 1 inch thick. A real space-saver and easy to pack!










