



### Dubai, United Arab Emirates

#### Family Values

Family is the cornerstone of Emirati society, and strong family ties are highly valued. Family gatherings are common, especially during religious holidays and special occasions. Respect for elders is paramount, and children are taught to honor and obey their parents.





#### Traditional Dress

Traditional clothing reflects Emirati heritage and identity. Emirati men typically wear a white anklelength garment called a kandura, while women wear a black robe called an abaya. These garments are worn as a symbol of modesty and cultural pride.

Emiratis are known for their welcoming nature and willingness to accommodate guests with food, drinks, and comfortable surroundings. Visitors are often greeted with Arabic coffee and dates, symbols of hospitality.
